Date of observation: 7 August 2009. Location: St. Kitts. Voucher: image. This is the first record of this species for the island of St. Kitts. It has been introduced in many parts of the world, and on other islands in the West Indies. Two individuals of this species were brought into the office of the St. Christopher National Trust office in Basseterre, St. Kitts. The exact locality where they were collected is unknown, and no other individuals have been seen or reported since then. Species identification was made by Robert W. Henderson (Milwaukee Public Museum).
