Chelonoidis carbonaria (Red-footed Tortoise). Distribution.

Date of observation: 27 April 2009. Location: St. Kitts. Individuals are being maintained at several places in Basseterre, as well as in Bourryeau and Camps. This species has been introduced on other islands in the West Indies. Its presence on St. Kitts has been noted previously (B. Horwith and K. Lindsay,

1999, A biodiversity profile of St. Kitts and Nevis, Eastern Caribbean Biodi versity Programme, St. John's, Antigua) but no localities were given.
