This is a range extension for this species in the Caicos Islands. One individual encountered active on the surface at 2315 hours in a karst field with Turks Head Cactus. Photographed and released at capture site. Color Photo Vouc- her APSU 18948. Verified by B. N. Manco and S. Blair Hedges. 20 March 2009. One individual

encountered under a rock partially buried in sandy soil at the base of a hill. These observations extend the known range of this species to the southeastern margin of the Caicos Bank.
