Eleutherodactylus glanduliferoides (La Selle Grass Frog). Conservation.

Date of observation: 20 November 2009. Location: Haiti: L'Ouest; 5 km S Furcy. Coordinates:18.3949, -72.2409. Elevation: 1586 m. This critically endangered species (IUCN, CR) was last found at this locality on 9 July 1985 but we did not see or hear it calling this evening. Frog activity was reduced, but we encountered *E. audanti*, *E. furcyensis*, and *E. inoptatus*. The rainy season had ended early and conditions were unusually dry, which may explain reduced frog activity. Accompanied by Elisabeth Rochel, Richard Thomas, and Eladio Fernandez.
