## *Osteopilus vastus* (Hispaniolan Giant Treefrog). Conservation.

Date of observation: 6 April 2011. Location: Dominican Republic: Sánchez Ramírez; Valle El Llegal. Coordinates: 18.5311534, -70.1015859. Elevation: 150 m. Voucher: image. Several adults of this endangered species (IUCN, EN) of hylid frog were observed in low vegetation along the Río El Llegal. This locality is one of several isolated sites from which the species has been reported previously that is capable of supporting a population of these frogs. Key habitat elements appear to be healthy forest associated with a flowing stream. Accompanied by Claude Gascon, Sixto J. Incháustegui, and Robert Powell.
