

***Alsophis rijgersmaei* (Anguilla Bank Racer).
Distribution.**

Date of observation: 15 August 2011. Location: St. Barthelemy, Îlet Tortue. Coordinates: 17.919, -62.799. Voucher: image. In a grass field on the Îlet Tortue, I observed a shed skin of a snake, probably of the species *Alsophis rijgersmaei*; a species also present on the main island of St. Barthelemy. The molt appeared old, brittle, and dried by the sun. The dense thickets on the island make research difficult and the reef limits access to the island. No living specimen has yet been observed. This is the first record of the species from Îlet Tortue.
