Anolis coelestinus (Southern Green Anole). Distribution.

Date of observation: 23 July 2010. Location: Haiti: Sud; Coteaux. Coordinates: 18.21355, -74.0381. Elevation: 7 m. Voucher: video. Surprisingly only two localities for this species are known on the entire southern coast of the distal Tiburon Peninsula between Les Cayes and Dame-Marie. This record fills a gap along that coast. Several individuals were

found sleeping on vegetation at night, along a side road on the outskirts of Coteaux. Accompanied by Richard Thomas. Thanks to Philippe Bayard and the Audubon Society of Haiti.
