

***Sphaerodactylus copei* (Haitian Big-scaled Sphaero). Distribution.**

Date of observation: 20 July 2010. Location: Haiti: Sud; 4.0 km E Les Anglais. Coordinates: 18.29685, -74.188717. Elevation: 77 m. Voucher: video. This species of gecko has been partitioned into nine subspecies in a relatively small area, the Tiburon Peninsula of Haiti. This specimen represents only the second known locality of *S. c. websteri*, collected in 1970 in nearby Les Anglais (type locality). This specimen was found under a dead agave on an open slope. Accompanied by Richard Thomas. Thanks to Philippe Bayard and the Audubon Society of Haiti.
